

High School students who have met the established requirements set forth in Wisconsin Statutes 118.55 may enroll in the Early College Credit Program. The district will pay for a maximum of 18 approved credits. If a student is enrolled in an Early College Credit approved course and receives a failing grade or fails to complete the course, the Board of Education may require reimbursement from the student or his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) for all costs related to the failed or incomplete course.

High School students who have met the established requirements set forth in Wisconsin Statutes 38.12 may enroll in the Start College Now Program. The district will pay for a maximum of 18 approved credits. If a student is enrolled in a technical college approved course and receives a failing grade or fails to complete the course, the Board of Education may require reimbursement from the student or his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) for all costs related to the failed or incomplete course.
