

Liability of Professional Staff:

Any instructor may be held personally liable for injury to students caused by the instructor's negligence. An instructor could find himself/herself involved in a costly lawsuit if a student is injured and the instructor is accused of failing to exercise reasonable care in performing his/her duties as an instructor. It is a fact of law that no school district or municipality is liable for the negligent acts of its instructors or other employees unless made so by statute. It therefore behooves an instructor never to leave an instructional area where he/she has students under his/her supervision.
