LOCKER ROOM PRIVACY JFG-A

The School District of Neillsville shall observe measures intended to protect the privacy rights of individuals using school locker rooms. The following provisions outline the extent to which that protection can and will be provided:

- 1. Locker rooms are provided for the use of physical education students, athletes, and other activity groups and individuals authorized by the building principal or by district policy.
- 2. No media will be permitted to enter into a locker room or remain in a locker room to interview or seek information from an individual at any time. Such interviews must take place outside of the locker room consistent with applicable district policies and/or school rules.
- 3. Under no circumstances can a person use a camera, video recorder, cell phone, or other recording device to capture, record, or transfer a representation of a nude or partially nude person in a locker room.
- 4. Any other use of a camera, video recorder, or other recording device in a locker room requires the prior permission of the building principal and the person being photographed, videotaped, or recorded.

Students or staff violating this policy shall be subject to school disciplinary action and possible legal referral, if applicable. Other persons violating the policy may be subject to penalties outlined in state law. The building principal or designated locker room supervisor shall be responsible for enforcing this policy.
