The Board of Education is legally responsible for all materials selected within the school district. The materials collection should include all facets of the curriculum with materials which reflect different points of view on all subjects. The collection should provide opportunities for students and staff to widen their search for information and inspiration.

The materials selection shall be a cooperative process in which all professional staff members and students should participate and shall incorporate the philosophy of the American Association of School Librarians', "School Library Bill of Rights".

The Board of Education recognizes a pluralistic society and shall provide an opportunity for parents or legal guardians to restrict material from their children by submitting, in writing, a list of objections on forms.
