

6th Grade 100% Remote Learning Plan

100% remote learners will only be required to do the work for their 4 core areas. Physical Education, Rotations, and Band/Music/Academic Elective will be optional for the students that are interested and want to have the opportunity to participate.

Students are not required to follow the below time schedule as they can do their coursework anytime during the day that works for the family. Below is the schedule in-person students will be following. If your family would like to utilize the below as a schedule to add structure to your student's learning day, feel free. Some teachers will be offering students with internet access to join their class live for the direct instruction, but will also be recording the lesson to be posted on Google Classroom to be viewed at a later time if that is better for the student and family's schedule. Other teachers will video their mini-lessons in advance to post on Google Classroom to be viewed at the student's convenience.

Hello! Welcome to 6th Grade English Language Arts! This year is starting out a little different, but as always, we are here to help! We are all learning and in this together.

If your student is attending school online, I will have a Google Classroom set up for them (our class code is "osy7yng"). These students will have access to lessons that are taught in class and recorded, then shared on our ELA Google Classroom. Under "Classwork" at the top of our Google Classroom, you will see a section for each week of school. Under this section, multiple things will be included such as weekly directions/schedule, daily video lessons, etc. Students will need to access ConnectEd often to read the stories that match with the lessons and to read their guided reading books. Student's ConnectEd usernames and passwords are inside of their ELA folders. Parents are encouraged to join my Google Classroom as a parent. Parents who join Google Classroom will receive weekly updates and be able to see which information and assignments their student has been given. With exception to our first week of school, our weeks follow pretty much the same schedule and are easy to get the hang of.

If your student is attending school remotely without the internet, I will have two binders for them that we will rotate out each week. When one week is finished, you will return the binder and pick up the next week's binder (swapping the two out each week so that there isn't a waiting period). I will then go through the binder, grade materials and give feedback. Within this binder you will find the lessons that we are participating in within the classroom along with the activities we are doing (with instructions). Your child will also have two textbooks (a BIG textbook and a small textbook) that their readings can be found in. I will always specify which textbook and page that day's story is found on.

I can't wait to get to know our awesome 6th grade class! Again, please let me know if you have any questions.
