
School District of Neillsville Facility Planning Community Survey Results




In November 2022, a survey was sent to area residents to gather feedback on proposed facility projects to address infrastructure updates, building renovations, and sustainability efforts. Community members were presented with \$10 million, \$12.5 million, and \$15.5 million options to address these needs.

The District received an impressive 32% response rate, including 355 direct mail responses and 330 online replies. Overall, the community supported this venture, with nearly 84% of respondents recommending the District pursue a referendum.

The Board of Education would like to thank area residents for their participation. The high response rate provided valuable information. The comments below list additional suggestions received through the survey. The Board will review these findings at the December 2022 meeting and determine the next steps in the facility planning process.
