Dear Families,

I would like to invite your child/ren to the Neillsville School District's summer school program. This program allows your child/ren chances to explore new things and expand their knowledge! Students that will complete 4K through 6th grade this school year are invited to attend. Students who will complete 7th & 8th grade, may participate in tutoring and/or swimming. However, any student who wants to tutor must have prior permission from Mrs. Kunze. In addition, 6th grade students through 11th grade can participate in Speed, Agility and Weight Lifting. Lastly, there are select classes for high school students.

The summer school program will look very different this year. Classes will start on Monday, June 3 and go until Friday, June 28. Classes are in session from 8:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Grade levels will be grouped together. Each grouping will have the following courses built into their schedule: Reading, Math, Art/Cooking, Swimming/Outdoor Games, and Computer Tech Ed. Students will still be able to explore fun and exciting activities within their homeroom class.

Below is the breakdown of each grouping:

- 4K - Is grouped together for "Kindergarten Readiness"
- 5k - 1st grade
- 2nd - 3rd grade
- 4th - 6th grade

Each student will have the opportunity to participate in swim lessons. However, if your child does not want to participate in swimming lessons, they will participate in Outdoor Games.

To enroll your child/ren into summer school please turn in the completed registration form to your child's teacher. Also, please indicate if your child will participate in swimming lessons. When signing up for summer school, use your child's **current grade level** from the 2023-2024 school year.

Breakfast and lunch services will be offered during summer school with NO cost for either meal for anyone 0 - 18 years of age. People ages 0 - 18 years can come to the Elementary Gym or designated area to eat. We will be serving breakfast from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. Any child in the community can come in for a free breakfast and lunch, but they must eat it in the gym or designated area. In addition, adults can eat with their children, but they must pay the adult meal price. The adult meal prices are yet to be determined.

There will be transportation available for students who are attending summer school. Transportation forms are due back to the office NO LATER than Wednesday, April 30th. Any forms turned in late are not guaranteed to have busing services available.

Current 4K Student Options

Current 4K students will continue their reading and math skills. As well as, working on art skills and having positive peer interactions. Swimming lessons are NOT available for these students.

5K - 6th Grade Options

Each grouping will have the following courses built into their schedule: Reading, Math, Art/Cooking, Swimming/Outdoor Games, and Computer Tech Ed. Each student will have the opportunity to participate in swim lessons. However, if your child does not want to participate in swimming lessons there will be an alternative activity planned.

Below is the breakdown of each grouping.

- 5k - 1st graders
- 2nd - 3rd graders
- 4th - 6th graders

Swim: times are listed below based on grade level:

8:30am - 9:20am for 7th - 8th graders

9:25am - 10:15am for 4th - 5th graders

10:15am - 11:05am for 2nd - 3rd graders

11:10am - 12:00pm for 5K - 1st graders

Golf: If your child (grade 4th - 8th) is interested in golf it will run from 8:30am - 11am. This course is held at the Neillsville Country Club. It is preferred that students own their own clubs, but it is not required. There are **NO** green fees.

Speed, Agility, and Weight Lifting (grades 6th -11th)

Students in this course will have the opportunity to improve their overall health, as well as, learn the proper techniques to improve strength, agility, and quickness. ALL students participating in extracurricular athletics are highly encouraged to attend!

7th - 8th Grade Options

Golf: If your child (grade 4th - 8th) is interested in golf it will run from 8:30am - 11am. This course is held at the Neillsville Country Club. It is preferred that students own their own clubs, but it is not required. There are **NO** green fees.

Swimming: Available time: 8:30am - 9:20am for 7th - 8th graders

Speed, Agility, and Weight Lifting (grades 6th -11th)

Students in this course will have the opportunity to improve their overall health, as well as, learn the proper techniques to improve strength, agility, and quickness. ALL students participating in extracurricular athletics are highly encouraged to attend!

Tutoring: Please call the Elementary office to discuss your child tutoring for summer school. All students interested in tutoring must have prior approval from Mrs. Kunze. There are no expectations.

High School Options

Speed, Agility, and Weight Lifting (grades 6th -11th)

Students in this course will have the opportunity to improve their overall health, as well as, learn the proper techniques to improve strength, agility, and quickness. ALL students participating in extracurricular athletics are highly encouraged to attend!

High School Reading & Composition 0.5 credits (Grades 9th - 11th)

This course is encouraged to students that need credit recovery in English or are wanting to earn credits. Students who enjoy reading and want to put their talents to the test, would be a good fit for this course.

High School Math 0.5 credits (Grades 9th - 11th)

This course is available to students who are in need of credit recovery. Students taking this course will be able to earn 0.5 credit. In addition, students that are interested in learning new math strategies and are ready to do some interesting tasks that involve numbers, breaking codes and graphing, are also encouraged to try this course!
