

**NEILLSVILLE BOARD OF EDUCATION  
MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING**

January 31, 2018

A special meeting of the Board of Education, School District of Neillsville was called to order on January 31, 2018, at 7:45 p.m. in the Board of Education Office by President Dewey Poeschel. Present at roll call were Dewey Poeschel, Deanna Heiman, Peggy Grap, and Sue Voigt. Rick Opelt was absent. Also present were Administrator John Gaier and MS/HS Principal Craig Anderson.

Notification of the meeting was sent to the Clark County Press and WCCN Radio.

Motion by Peggy Grap seconded by Sue Voigt to go into closed session under Sections 19.85(1)(a) and 19.85 (1)(f) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The purpose of the closed meeting is to conduct an expulsion hearing in accordance with Section 120.13 (1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes and to review and discuss pupil records, as defined in Section 118.125 of the Wisconsin Statutes. This closed session will deal with the possible expulsion of a middle school student for conduct while at school and while under the supervision of a school authority which endangered the property, health or safety of others; and whether the student skipped a class and had sexual contact with another student, while at school or while under the supervision of a school authority. Roll call: Peggy Grap – yes; Deanna Heiman – yes; Sue Voigt – yes; Dewey Poeschel – yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sue Voigt seconded by Peggy Grap to expel a middle school student for the remainder of the 2017-2018 school year for skipping class and having sexual contact with another student while at school and under the supervision of school authority. Terms of the expulsion shall be: (1) The student be expelled from the schools of the School District of Neillsville through June 5, 2018; (2) The student will be allowed back to school to attend classes beginning February 26, 2018, on days school is in session. The student cannot be on school grounds during non-school hours; (3) The student can lose condition #2 if the high school principal deems appropriate based on the student's behavior. Roll call: Sue Voigt – yes; Peggy Grap – yes; Deanna Heiman – yes; Dewey Poeschel – yes. Motion carried.
