NEILLSVILLE BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING

February 7, 2019

A special meeting of the Board of Education, School District of Neillsville was called to order on February 7, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Education Office by President Dewey Poeschel. Present at roll call were Dewey Poeschel, Peggy Grap, Rick Opelt, and Sue Voigt. Also present was Administrator John Gaier.

Notification of the meeting was sent to the Clark County Press and WCCN Radio.

Motion by Sue Voigt seconded by Peggy Grap to go into closed session under Sections 19.85(1)(a) and 19.85 (1)(f) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The purpose of the closed meeting is to conduct an expulsion hearing in accordance with Section 120.13 (1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes and to review and discuss pupil records, as defined in Section 118.125 of the Wisconsin Statutes. This closed session will deal with the possible expulsion of a high school student for conduct while at school and while under the supervision of a school authority which endangered the property, health or safety of others. Roll call: Peggy Grap – yes, Sue Voigt – yes, Dewey Poeschel – yes, Rick Opelt – yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Sue Voigt seconded by Peggy Grap to expel a high school student for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year for conduct while not at school and while not under the supervision of a school authority which endangered the property, health or safety of others. Terms of the expulsion shall be: (1) The student be expelled from the schools of the School District of Neillsville through June 7, 2019; (2) The student will be allowed to continue with their current coursework beginning February 8, 2019. The district will assign a representative to provide course materials and academic support. The student cannot be on school grounds until June 7, 2019, unless prior approval is given by administration; (3) As of April 2, 2019, the student will be allowed to attend classes and participate in co-curricular activities under an early re-entry provision of the expulsion; (4) The student can lose condition #2 and #3 if the high school principal deems appropriate based on the student's behavior.
