

DECORUM AT BOARD MEETINGS

BDDHA

Members of the public who attend Board of Education meetings, or board committee meetings, shall conduct themselves in a manner which will ensure a safe, orderly and efficient meeting.

Members of the public will be allowed to speak to the Board of Education and board committees on matters of public concern at the times designated for such purpose. The time and length of such is regulated by the board.

Shouting, audible comments or other disruptive noise or movements at times other than the designated time for that person to speak will not be tolerated.

Any person who attempts to disrupt the proceedings in a manner contrary to what has been stated will be asked by the presiding officer to cease and desist from such conduct.

If the person refuses to cease and desist or repeats such conduct, that person will be asked to leave the meeting room.

If such person refuses, law enforcement authorities may be called to assist in that person's removal. In such cases, the district could pursue disorderly conduct or other appropriate charges.
