

8th Grade 100% Remote Learning Plan

100% remote learners will only be required to do the work for their 4 core areas. Physical Education, rotation courses, music will be optional for the students that are interested and want to have the opportunity to participate.

Students are not required to follow the below time schedule as they can do their coursework anytime during the day that works for the family. Below is the schedule in-person students will be following. If your family would like to utilize the below as a schedule to add structure to your student's learning day, feel free. Some teachers will be offering students with internet access to join their class live for the direct instruction, but will also be recording the lesson to be posted on Google Classroom to be viewed at a later time if that is better for the student and family's schedule. Other teachers will video their mini-lessons in advance to post on Google Classroom to be viewed at the student's convenience.

8th grade math students with Mrs. Brown will be provided with a hardcover textbook and an online textbook account. Students will be sent homework and weekly plans once a week. Information will also be provided via Google Classroom and can be found in my virtual classroom online. Parents are encouraged to open my virtual classroom and submit the form in order to join my Google Classroom as a parent. Parents who join Google Classroom will receive weekly updates and be able to see which information and assignments their student has been given. Please save the link for my virtual classroom future use as I will use it as a way of communicating the weekly plan for math class. I will be posting instructional videos on Google Classroom, and also hope to go live for some interactive teaching of the weekly lessons. All live sessions will follow the Monday/Wednesday cohort (with the first two weeks of school being on Wednesday/Friday). 8th grade will go live from 8:59-9:54 on those days. If you're unable to attend the live session, the video will be posted to Google Classroom to view at a later time. If you're ever in need of assistance, please reach out to me and we can arrange to set up a time to help you. Please stay connected with me, both parents and students, as we maneuver through this new way of learning together! Any feedback you may have is always welcome.

- I will be using Google Classroom to post announcements and assignments. I will communicate with students and parents via email, phone calls, text messages, and video conferencing.
- All students will be assigned a hard copy of the textbook as well as access to the textbook online.
- Lessons/presentations will be recorded and uploaded on Google Classroom. Practice sheets will be also uploaded to Google Classroom and students will be able to type on them and turn them in online.
- For those that request hardcopies of assignments, those will be sent home and returned via drop off or mail.
- I plan to do bi-weekly check-ins with students during my prep period (6th hour).
- Adjustments to these plans may be necessary from time to time.

Students will be provided with any novels that will be read as a class. Students will be added to Google Classroom and can find links for weekly lessons there. These lessons will NOT be live but pre recorded mini lessons. There will be two lessons each week that will be posted every Monday for students to engage in watching. There will also be assignments and practice work posted on Google Classroom as well. Students can type in these documents and turn them in via Google Classroom when they are completed. In addition, I ask that every student take 10 minutes each day to sit down and read a book of their choice. Parents can join Google Classroom if they wish to see weekly updates on their child. I will communicate with students and parents via email, phone calls, or zoom. If students request paper copies, these will be sent home. If you ever have any questions or need assistance with anything, please do not hesitate to reach out to me and we can work through it together.

American History will be run primarily through Google Classroom. Students will be added to Google Classroom and can find everything they will need there. The American History live class will run from 11:57-12:52 and that link will be posted in the banner of Google Classroom daily. This lesson will be recorded and then posted after the live session for those that choose to not attend class live or would like to revisit the lesson. I will contact your child through email with their login information to our American History textbook. The majority of materials will be posted to Google Classroom and will be in digital form unless other arrangements are made. I will also schedule times to check in with your child individually to help with any questions. See the American History flyer for more information. If any of these plans change I will make sure you are informed. Please know that I am always available by email or by appointment through the phone or Google Meet to help with anything and I will be flexible to any problems or needs that may come up.
