Dear Families,

I would like to invite your child/ren to the Neillsville School District's summer school program. This program allows your child/ren chances to explore new things and expand their knowledge! Students that will complete 4K through 8th grade this school year are invited to attend. In addition, we have opportunities for 7th - 11th graders to be tutors in the classrooms with prior permission from Mrs. Kunze. Sixth grade through 11th grade students can participate in speed, agility and weight lifting. Lastly, there are select classes for high school students through Rural Virtual Academy (RVA).

Classes will start on Monday, June 1st and go until Friday, June 26. Classes are in session from 8:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Grade levels will be grouped together. Each elementary classroom grouping will have the following courses built into their schedule:

Reading, math, art/cooking, swimming/outdoor games, and computer tech ed. Students will still be able to explore fun and exciting activities within their homeroom class. Sixth through 8th grade students will have a flexible schedule to be able to do creative activities, speed, agility, and weight lifting and swimming.

Below is the breakdown of each grouping:

- 4K - Is grouped together for "Kindergarten Readiness"
- 5k - 1st grade
- 2nd - 3rd grade
- 4th - 5th grade
- 6th - 8th grade

Students in 5K - 8th grade for the 2025-26 school year will have the opportunity to participate in swim lessons. Students in 4K for the 2025-26 school year will not have swimming. However, if your child does not want to participate in swimming lessons, they will participate in outdoor games.

To enroll your child/ren into summer school please turn in the completed registration form to your child's teacher. Also, please indicate if your child will participate in swimming lessons. When signing up for summer school, use your child's current grade level from the 2025-2026 school year.

Breakfast and lunch services will be offered during summer school with **NO** cost for either meal for anyone 0 - 18 years of age. People ages 0 - 18 years can come to the Elementary Gym. We will be serving breakfast from 7:45 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. Any child in the community can come in for a free breakfast and lunch.. In addition, adults can eat with their children, but they must pay the adult meal price. The adult meal prices are yet to be determined.

There will be transportation available for students who are attending summer school. Transportation forms are due back to the office **NO LATER** than Tuesday, April 17th. Any forms turned in late are not guaranteed to have busing services available.

Current 4K Student Options

Current 4K students will continue their reading and math skills. As well as, working on art skills and having positive peer interactions. Swimming lessons are NOT available for these students.

5K - 5th Grade Options

Each grouping will have the following courses built into their schedule: Reading, Math, Art/Cooking, Swimming/Outdoor Games, and Computer Tech Ed. Each student will have the opportunity to participate in swim lessons. However, if your child does not want to participate in swimming lessons there will be an alternative activity planned.

Below is the breakdown of each grouping.

- 5k - 1st graders
- 2nd - 3rd graders
- 4th - 5th graders

Swim: times are listed below based on grade level:

8:30am - 9:20am for 6th - 8th graders

9:25am - 10:15am for 4th - 5th graders

10:15am - 11: 05am for 2nd - 3rd graders

11:10am - 12:00pm for 5K - 1st graders

Golf: If your child (grade 4th - 8th) is interested in golf it will run from 8:30am - 11am. This course is held at the Neillsville Country Club. It is preferred that students own their own clubs, but it is not required. There are **NO** green fees. This course has limited spaces. Therefore, it is vital to sign up early.

Speed, Agility, and Weight Lifting (grades 6th -11th)

Students in this course will have the opportunity to improve their overall health, as well as, learn the proper techniques to improve strength, agility, and quickness. ALL students participating in extracurricular athletics are highly encouraged to attend!

6th - 8th Grade Options

Golf: If your child (grade 4th - 8th) is interested in golf it will run from 8:30am - 11am. This course is held at the Neillsville Country Club. It is preferred that students own their own clubs, but it is not required. There are **NO** green fees.

Middle School Jumpstart: A summer school course for grades 6th - 8th that focuses on blending core academics with fun, active engagement that will give middle school students an academic boost in reading, writing, and math.

Swimming: Available time: 8:30am - 9:20am for 6th - 8th graders

Speed, Agility, and Weight Lifting (grades 6th -11th)

Students in this course will have the opportunity to improve their overall health, as well as, learn the proper techniques to improve strength, agility, and quickness. ALL students participating in extracurricular athletics are highly encouraged to attend!

Tutoring (7th - 11th grades): Please call the Elementary office to discuss your child tutoring for summer school. All students interested in tutoring must have prior approval from Mrs. Kunze.

High School Options

Speed, Agility, and Weight Lifting (grades 6th -11th)

Students in this course will have the opportunity to improve their overall health, as well as, learn the proper techniques to improve strength, agility, and quickness. ALL students participating in extracurricular athletics are highly encouraged to attend!

RVA Courses - These are available to students. They would need to speak to the high school guidance counselor for more information to register for specific offerings through RVA (Rural Virtual Academy).
